



Public Collections

If you would like to order your own club collection tins or buckets with labels, you can order them from [Angal®](#).

They offer a large number of options including [Ready to Use Collection Kits](#). Prices vary according to how many tins you buy and the style you choose. Tins and buckets come with labels (artwork to be provided by you, which must include your club logo and the charity registration number 800329) and seals.

Angal® can also produce flagday lapel stickers at a cost of £12.50 per 1000.

You may also require t-shirts for your volunteers to wear on the day – these can be purchased from the Special Olympics GB online shop:

PLEASE NOTE

Please be aware that you MUST ask your local council for permission to collect in public places. You will be issued with a licence that MUST be carried by all the collectors when collecting. It is illegal to collect with permission and without the licence.

Please do not do house to house collections: they are illegal without the proper licence and people can find them intrusive. Public collections are no problem if they are on private property (for instance at a supermarket).
