# History

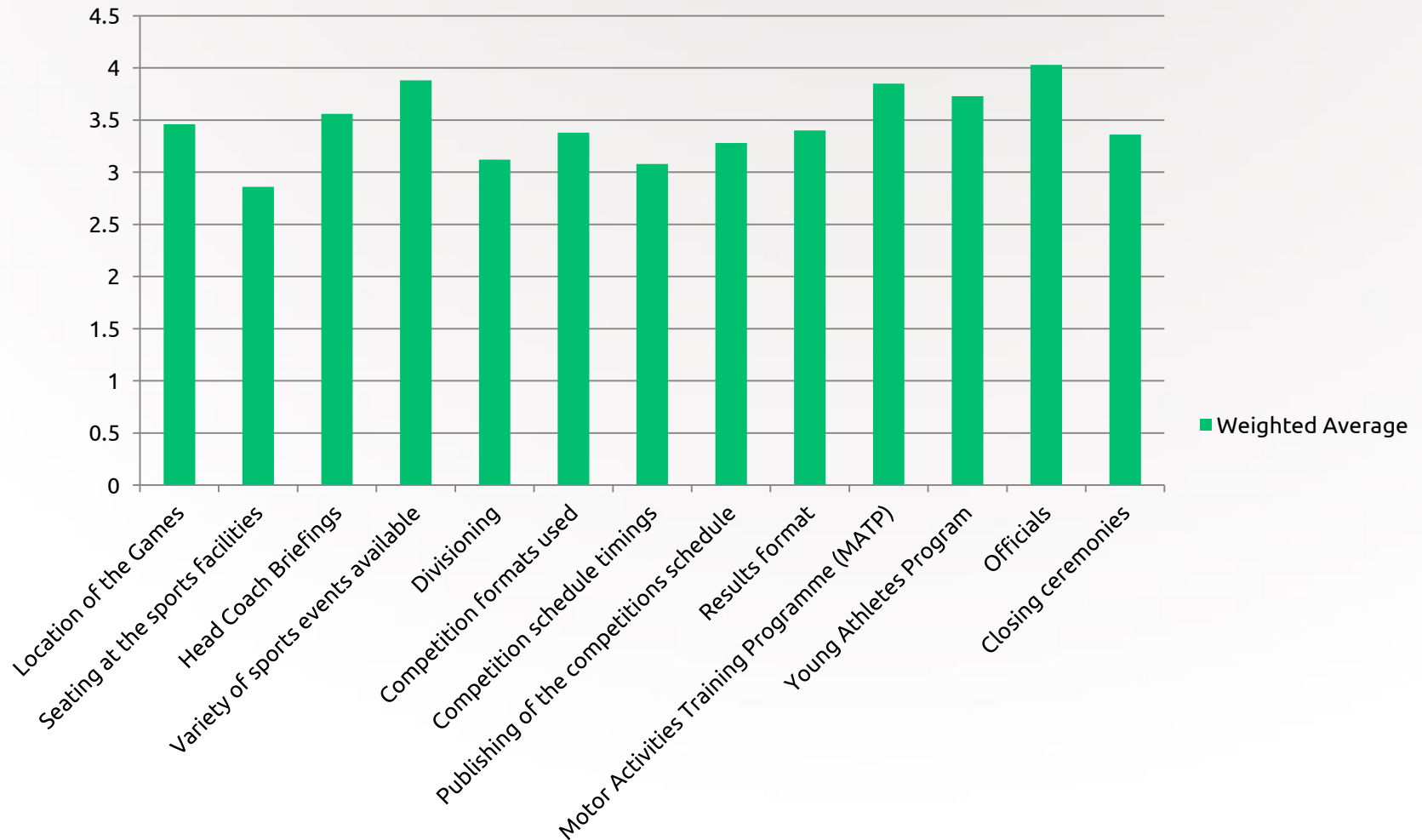


- First National Summer Games held in Knowlsley, Liverpool in 1982 with 800 athletes

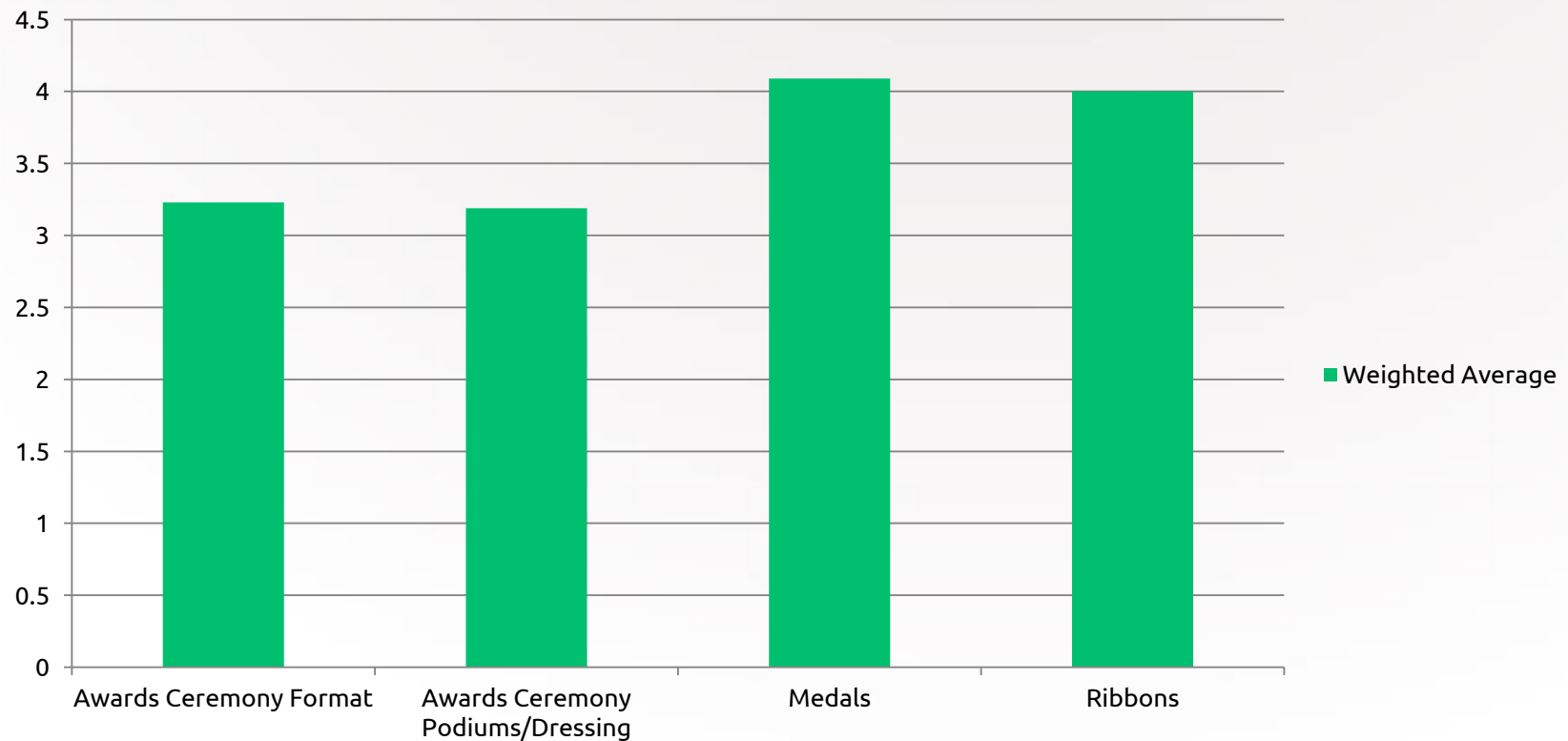

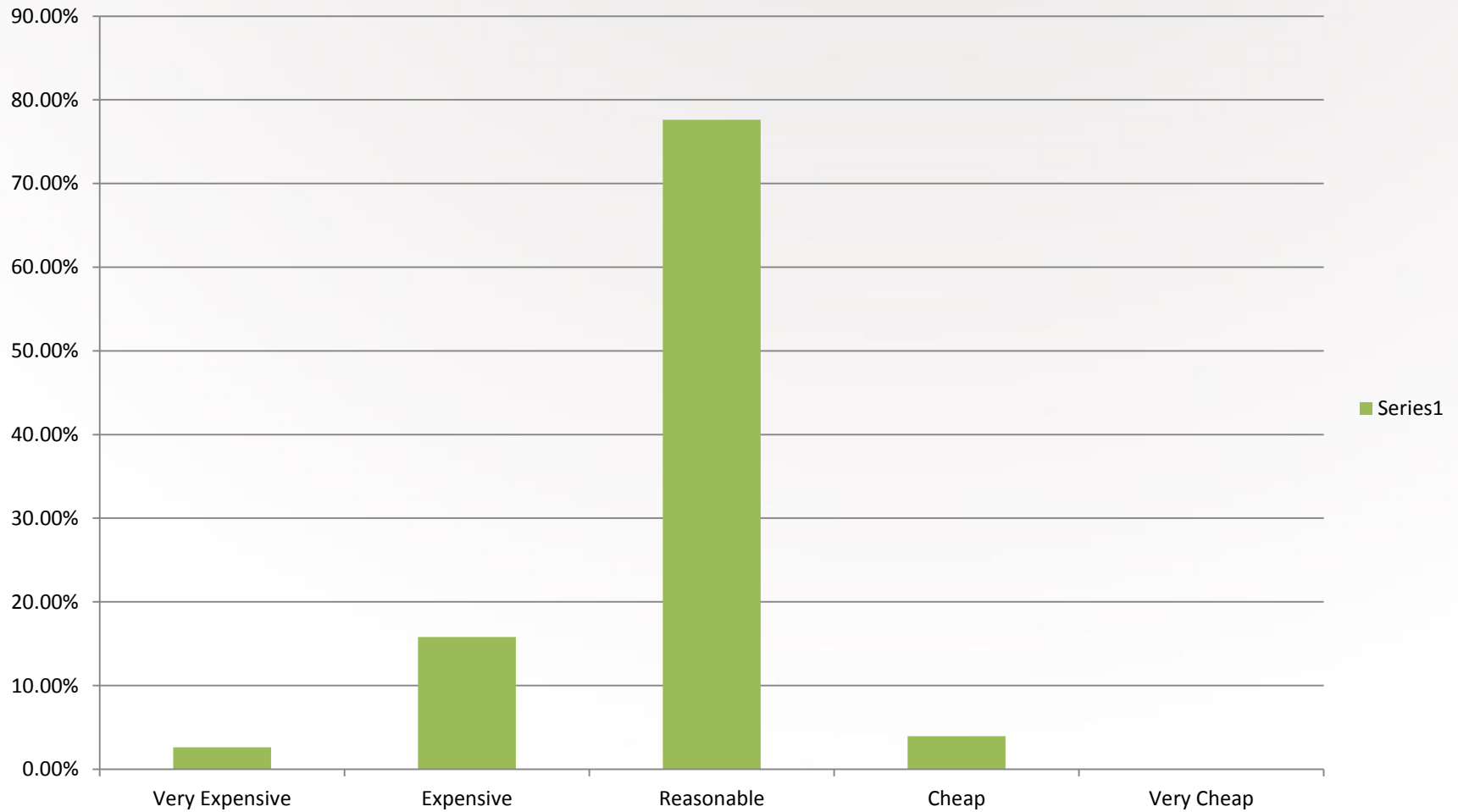

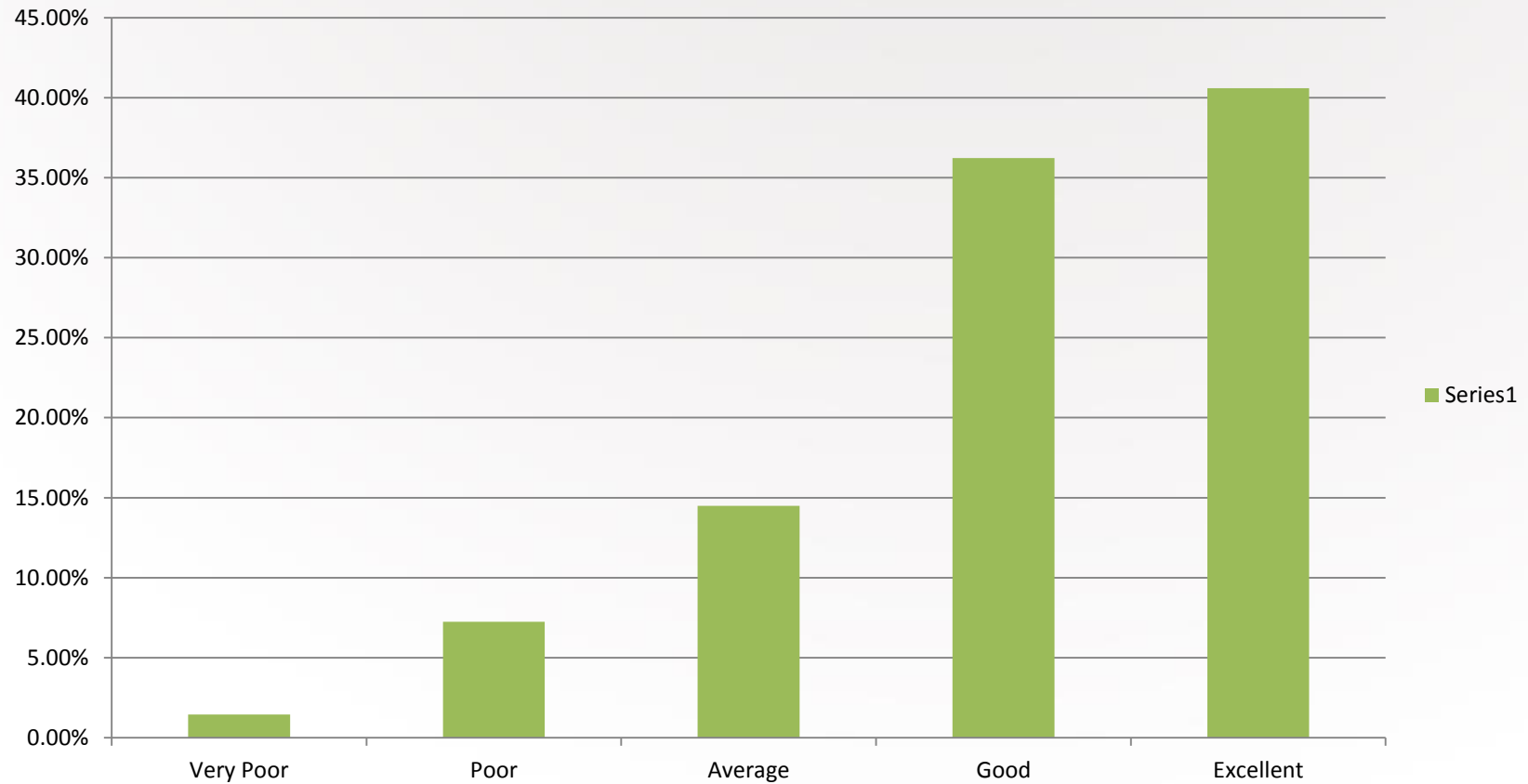
